Theatre in the Grove is proud to participate in the Regional Arts & Cultural Council's Arts for All program. We want live community theatre to be accessible to people of all ages and economic statuses.

We offer \$5 tickets to holders of the Oregon Trail Card. Up to 2 tickets per event can be purchased for a single Oregon Trail Card.

In the past, these tickets were only available for purchase at the box office when you physically presented the Oregon Trail card to our staff. However, through the power of technology we are now able to offer these tickets via our online ticketing portal for your convenience.


If you are receiving these instructions, then you already have sent us an electronic copy of your Oregon Trail card and you have been set up in our ticketing portal for access to this special ticket type.

Once a year, you will need to requalify by sending us an electronic copy of your Oregon Trail card.

Here's how to use your Arts for All Pass.

Arts for All Email


Along with this email, you should have received an email from "Ludus", our ticketing provider with a link to view your Arts for All pass. It will look like this:



Click on View Your pass. You can ignore the part about recurring payment. This is a free program, other than the price of the ticket that you pay when you purchase a ticket. There are no recurring payments.


Purchasing a Ticket

A browser will open and you'll see the following:




Click on Get Tickets.

This will open a list of all events that we have and the dates/times of each performance:



Click on the 'Get Tickets' button for the performance that you want to attend. All of the shows for this season are visible, so you can purchase tickets to the current show or a future one.


Choose your Seats



Green circles represent available seats. The stage is at the top. Therefore, the rows near the top are closest to the stage. Empty areas with a wheelchair logo next to them are accessible seats. Using your mouse, click on the seat(s) that you want. They turn yellow.


Select Ticket Type

This step is important! Make sure you have selected the \$5 Arts for All ticket type:




Don't accidentally select one of the higher priced seats that are also available to you.

But, if you want to buy more seats that your two Arts for All seats, select all the seats that you want to buy in the diagram, and then you will be able to select which two get the Arts for All price and then you can select a different ticket type:




Provide Patron Contact Information

Next provide your contact information. You will do this only once and then it will be remembered for you later.




Press Add to Cart to add these tickets to your cart.

You'll be asked to verify the seats and ticket types:




If everything looks good, then click on Proceed to Payment.



Enter Payment Information

Provide your payment information and click on Confirm & Purchase.



After the purchase is complete, you will be given the option to have the tickets sent to you via email, text, print them on your home printer, or pick them up at will call.

Final Notes

Keep the passcode handy and you can use it again for any show this season. There is no need to show your Oregon Trail Card for other shows nor when you arrive at the theatre.
