DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Catch Me If You Can captures the astonishing true story of Frank Abagnale, Jr., a world-class con artist who passes himself as a doctor, a lawyer, and a Pan Am jet pilot...all before the age of 21. With straight-arrow FBI agent Carl Hanratty on Frank's trail, we're off on a jet-setting, cat and mouse chase, as a jazzy, swinging, sixties score keeps this adventure in constant motion. The concept of a 'show within a show' has always been intriguing to me, and this one, in particular, will play out in an episodic fashion while on set and on the air, similar to the early 60s variety shows like Hullabaloo or Hollywood a Go-Go. And as we are Live in Living Color, a clever story unfolds with surprising heart. This attracted me to the show, this story, to this material in the first place....And what colorful stories ensue around the life of Frank Abagnale, Jr.! The musical chronicles the journey of our protagonist who is really a boy in a man's world in a very different time and place that we live today. Bringing this story to life with this talented cast and amazing crew has been a total thrill!
